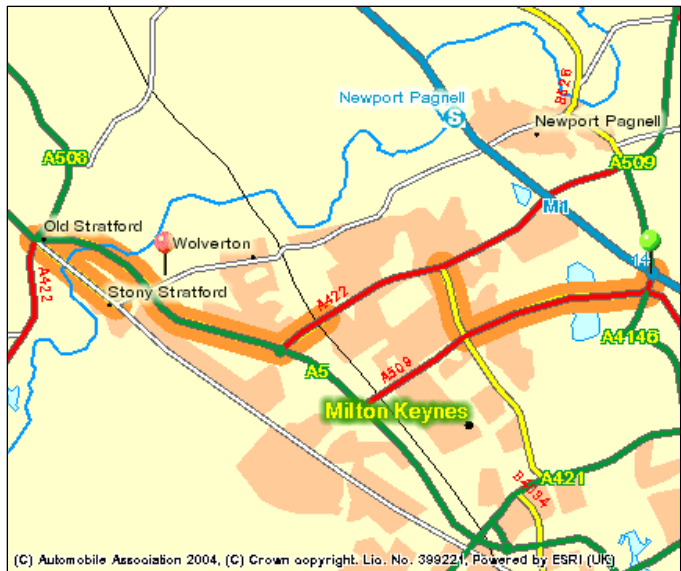


## Directions to Skills for Logistics

For instructions travelling from the North please see separate sheet.

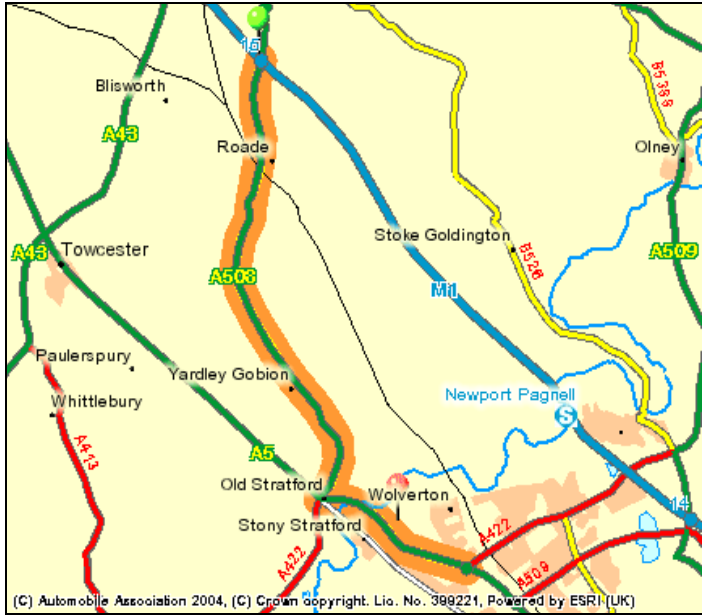
As a new town Milton Keynes is famous for its roundabouts and grid road network. To help you find us here are directions from M1 Junction 14.

The route covers 13 roundabouts, some of which have visible name signs.

To make best use of the instructions, please zero your trip meter as you reach the end of the exit ramp.

0.5	A509	Pass Marriott Courtyard Hotel on right
1.2	A509	<b>1<sup>st</sup> exit at roundabout,</b> <i>Signed A422 to Milton Keynes North and Buckingham</i>
1.8	A422	<b>2<sup>nd</sup> exit at Marsh End roundabout</b>
2.2	A422	Bridge across M1(Texaco petrol station on left, Shell petrol station on right)
2.8	H3 Monks Way	<b>2<sup>nd</sup> exit at Blakelands roundabout,</b> <i>Signed to Milton Keynes North, South and West</i>
3.2	H3 Monks Way	<b>2<sup>nd</sup> exit at Great Linford roundabout,</b> <i>Signed A422 to Milton Keynes South and West and Buckingham</i>
3.6	H3 Monks Way	<b>2<sup>nd</sup> exit at Red bridge roundabout,</b> <i>Signed to Buckingham, Dunstable and Aylesbury</i>
4.3	H3 Monks Way	<b>2<sup>nd</sup> exit at Stantonbury roundabout,</b> Signed to Buckingham
4.9	H3 Monks Way	<b>2<sup>nd</sup> exit at Bancroft roundabout,</b> <i>Signed to Milton Keynes West, Buckingham, Northampton and Dunstable</i>
5.4	H3 Monks Way	Underneath railway bridge
5.5	H3 Monks Way	<b>2<sup>nd</sup> exit at Stacey Bushes roundabout</b>
5.9	H3 Monks Way	<b>5<sup>th</sup> exit at (large) A5 roundabout</b> <i>Brown (tourist)sign to Museum of Industry and Rural life, V5 Great Monks Street</i>
6.5	V5 Great Monks Way	<b>2<sup>nd</sup> exit at Hodge Lea roundabout</b> <i>Signed to Buckingham, Northampton (local signs to Greenleys and Wolverton)</i>
7.2		<b>2<sup>nd</sup> exit at roundabout</b> <i>Signed to Buckingham, Northampton (local signs to Greenleys, Wolverton, Wolverton Mill and Stony Stratford)</i>
7.6	Stratford Road	<b>1<sup>st</sup> exit at double roundabout</b> <i>Signed to Buckingham, Northampton A422</i>
7.8	Stratford Road	<b>1<sup>st</sup> left turn (with bollards),</b> <i>Warren Farm Office Village - onto Harnett Drive</i>
7.9	Harnett Drive	Over speed hump, follow road round left hand bend, <b>1<sup>st</sup> left</b> into Warren Yard, and at the bottom of the road turn right to find no.12

1.1	A508	<b>Speed camera *****</b>
2.2	A508	<b>2nd exit at mini roundabout,</b> <i>Stay on A508</i>
2.4	A508	<b>Speed camera *****</b>
5.3	A508	Pass through Grafton Regis
5.5	A508	Pass White Hart public house on left
9.2	A508	<b>2<sup>nd</sup> exit at (large) A5 roundabout,</b> <i>Signed Old Stratford and Stony Stratford</i>
9.5		<b>Straight across traffic lights,</b> Pass SAAB dealership on right
9.7		Cross stone bridge and stay on road bearing to left
10.5		<b>1<sup>st</sup> exit at roundabout,</b> <i>Signed to Milton Keynes South and East</i>
	Stratford Road	Underneath road bridge
10.9		<b>1<sup>st</sup> right turn (filter lane),</b> Onto Harnett Drive
11.0	Harnett Drive	Over speed hump, follow road round left hand bend, 1 <sup>st</sup> left into Warren Yard, and at the bottom of the road turn right to find no.12

## Directions to Skills for Logistics

### *Travelling from the West*



As a new town Milton Keynes is famous for its roundabouts and grid road network. Fortunately, as you are approaching from the west, you won't have to grapple with them.

Coming from Bristol, South Wales or South West England will involve the M4 or A40 (from Gloucestershire). Get to the A34 west of Oxford (J15 or 13 of M4 or via A40) and head north until you join the M40 at J9.

Go north on M40 for one junction and come off at J10, following signs to Northampton on the A43

After 3 miles turn right at the roundabout clearly signed A421 Milton Keynes

Keep on the A421 which becomes the by pass to the south of Buckingham, when you see the big hotel/Esso garage on your right start getting ready to leave the A421.

Go straight across a roundabout by a Little Chef where there is a right turn to Tesco and Aylesbury – at the next roundabout **do not go straight on** on A421 to Milton Keynes but turn left signed Towcester and Milton Keynes North.

Shortly after this go over a small suburban roundabout and at the next roundabout turn right, signed A 422 Stony Stratford and MK North.

Keep on the A422 through the Buckinghamshire and Northamptonshire countryside for about 8 miles until you come to a large roundabout with traffic lights where the A422 meets the A5.

Go right round this, taking the final exit to Stony Stratford, passing another Little Chef on your left.

Follow the road through Old Stratford, then follow the road round to the left as it bends away from the straight roman road that goes into Stony Stratford itself.

At the roundabout turn left, go under the A5 and after about 150 yards there is a right turn marked "Warren Farm Office Village".

Turn in there, follow the road round to the left.

Skills for Logistics is at the bottom of the road on your right hand side, please ask at reception for guidance on availability of parking space.

**By Rail**

Virgin Trains (express) run from London (Euston) or Birmingham to Milton Keynes. Silver Link trains (non-express) run to Milton Keynes and Wolverton

**From Milton Keynes Station**

Bus routes No 2 and 23 both serve the Wolverton Mill area.

Leave the No 2 bus just after the Greenleys roundabout. Leave the No 23 bus just after the double mini roundabout.

A car-taxi from Milton Keynes Station to Warren Farm Office Village costs about £6 to £7 (phone 01908 222111, or 01908 260260 to book). Black cabs are more expensive.

**From Wolverton Station**

Bus 23 can be used. Leave the station and turn right. Proceed over the railway to the Tesco double mini-roundabout. Turn left into Creed Street and then turn right into Church Street where the buses stop near the Agora Centre. They run about every 20 minutes. Leave the bus just after the double mini roundabout.

**By Air / Coach**

London Luton is the nearest airport to Milton Keynes. National Express run from Luton and Stansted Airports to Milton Keynes Coachway at M1 Junction 14 - about 1 every 2 hours.

National Express run from Heathrow and Gatwick Airports to Northampton via Milton Keynes Coachway at M1 Junction 14 - about 1 per hour.

A car-taxi from Milton Keynes Coachway to Warren Farm Office Village costs about £10 (phone 01908 222111, or 01908 260260 to book). Black cabs are more expensive.
